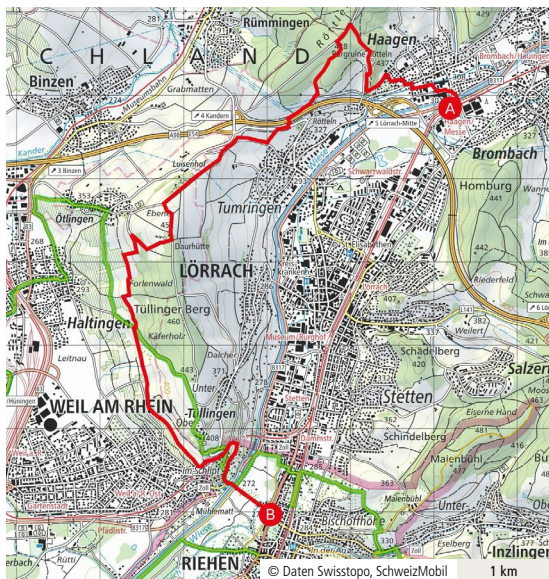

Röttler Schloss

From Brombach/D to Riehen



Itinerary:

Lörrach Haagen/Messe (301) – Burgruine Rötteln (437) – Daurhütte (452) – Ober Tüllingen (408) – Riehen (276)

The Röttler Schloss is a remarkable landmark on a rocky hill in the lower Wiesental. It offers an unexpected view of the city of Basel and its surroundings. On the Tüllinger Berg we can spot the Rhine valley and the adjacent Alsace. Depending on the advancement of the spring season we may explore the rare wild tulipes in the vineyards. The star-like flowers are famous as they convert the scraggy vineyards into a yellow ocean.

Bring your own food and drink

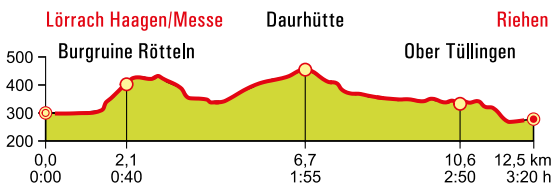
